



RULES OF THE CARLTON CRICKET CLUB (the "Rules") – January 2019

1. Application for Ordinary Membership

- (1) Every person or organisation wishing to become a member shall apply in writing or by electronic means to the Club Membership Secretary in such form as Carlton Cricket Club ("the Club") may direct;
- (2) The directors may refuse to admit any person or organisation to membership by a majority of the directors & the applicant will be given notice of the reasons therefor.

2. Honorary Members

- (1) Members of another club which falls within the definition of 'Clubs prescribed for the purposes of Section 125(1)' of the Licensing (Scotland) Act 2005 & within Section 2(1) & 2(2) of The Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2007, while on the Club's premises, will be deemed honorary members of the Club;
- (2) Article 7(6) of Carlton Cricket Club Articles of Association allows honorary life members to be elected by the Club at general meeting in recognition of long & meritorious service to the Club & as such they shall enjoy the same rights & privileges as ordinary members;
- (3) No person who has had their membership of the Club terminated by a majority vote of the directors in line with Article 10 (3) of the Club's Articles of Association may be an honorary member.

3. Guests

- (1) Members of the general public can enter the grounds when a senior match is scheduled, or in progress, although the directors reserve the right to refuse entry;
- (2) Members shall be entitled to introduce guests to the Club ground & facilities. No more than ten guests can be invited at any one time by a member on to the premises to be supplied with alcohol.

4. Sale of Alcohol

- (1) No alcoholic liquor shall be sold or supplied to any person under the age of 18 years;
- (2) Other than where an occasional licence has effect, no person is to be supplied with alcohol on the Club premises other than in the circumstances outlined in The Licensing (Clubs) (Scotland) Regulations 2007.

5. Conduct of Members & Guests

- (1) Any member playing in or spectating at any cricket match involving a team of the Club, or at another cricket match at a Carlton ground, who conducts themselves in a manner which in the opinion of the directors is likely to bring the Club or the game of cricket into disrepute, may be expelled from membership;
- (2) All members & guests are responsible for ensuring that the Club's ground is used appropriately, must adhere to the instructions of ground staff regarding use of the playing area & should remain off the cricket square;
- (3) Any director may require any member & any guest who in their opinion is deemed in a drunken state or who conducts themselves in a disorderly & anti-social manner to leave the Club's premises;
- (4) Any member who fails to leave the Club's premises when requested to do so by a director, & the member who introduced any guest who fails to leave the Club's premises when requested to do so by a director, may be expelled from membership;
- (5) The rules relating to members & guests bringing dogs into the ground at Grange Loan are as follows:
 - i. Dogs are prohibited from being in the ground during primary school practice sessions & junior social functions;
 - ii. During all other practice sessions, social activities & cricket matches, owners must always have their dogs on a leash & under control;
 - iii. At any other time, members & guests must always keep their dogs under control & in sight, particularly after dark;
 - iv. Dogs are not allowed on the cricket square at any time.

Any accidental fouling must be cleared immediately & either removed from the ground or placed in a suitable bag & deposited in the dog waste bin to the side of the main gate.

- (6) The Club is committed to providing an environment which is welcoming to all individuals regardless of race, sex, religion, sexual orientation, disability or other unjustified distinction & the directors of the Club aim to identify & prevent all instances of discrimination.
