Captain Selection Process

Objective

Captains play a key role in the successful operation of each team in Carlton, leading the team and creating a positive sporting and community environment.

The principal role of captains is to:

- Leading a cometitive team on the field
- Being part of selection panel with other captains and Head Coach
- Communicating player roles before matches, and communicating with unselected players in advance of selection being announced
- Building a positive, winning and supportive team environment; representing Club values, supporting players in their team, providing advice and feedback
- Working with vice captains to support their role and share the workload as required

This document sets out a selection process for captains across adult teams at Carlton Cricket Club that is open, fair, practical and encourages applicants from everyone at the club.

Process

- 1. Appoint a captain selection group, comprising a minimum of three Club members from:
 - Head of Cricket
 - Head Coach or equivalent
 - Senior Player or Member of Cricket Committee
- 2. Understand if existing captains are willing to stand if so, a selection group will meet to confirm the appointment for following season if it is deemed that a change is required this will be communicated by Head of Cricket.
- 3. Identify vacancies to be filled
- 4. Announce vacancies to the players in the Club via approved communication channel (Pitchero) supported by other media as required (e.g. Whatsapp)
- 5. Selection group reviews applicants lists and generates a short list if required
- 6. Selection group meets candidates to discuss their plans and suitability for the role
- 7. Selection group agrees selected candidates
- 8. Head of Cricket communicates outcome of the selection process to unsuccessful applicants
- 9. Head of Cricket communicates outcome of the selection process to the Club
