Annex - Motion for subscriptions for the 2025 season

The Management Committee of the Club is responsible for the motion for membership subscriptions which is being proposed at the 2025 AGM. In 2023 we fully refreshed the subscriptions model, with a particular focus on ensuring that junior and women's subscriptions were structured to more fairly reflect the amount of cricket (and cricket coaching) available to all players. In 2024, changes to subscriptions were kept to a minimum.

We announced last year that there would be a re-structuring of the Groundskeeping team and process for the 2024 season, and the investment of a considerable amount into the new hybrid pitches and other cricketing facilities. As a result, the Committee indicated at last year's AGM that we would consider increases in subscriptions for 2025 to ensure that the Club's finances remain on a sustainable footing.

We therefore propose an increase in subscriptions for 2025 of approximately 5% in aggregate, as follows:

We are exploring options for upgrading the changing, showering and toilet facilities at the Masterton Pavilion to ensure that they are equally appropriate for men's and women's players. Once this work is complete, we expect that women's playing subscriptions are likely to increase at a somewhat faster rate than others.

The above rates continue to include all league and cup match fees.

As in previous years, the club will be instituting a no-pay, no-play policy with respect to senior subscriptions, if subscriptions are not paid in full by 31 May.

We are proposing a slight change to the additional subscriptions for juniors playing senior cricket, mostly to reflect the value which junior players obtain from attending senior training.

Girl's hardball, U14 and U16 playing shirts will be available to buy, although the Club will also retain a stock of shirts for use by occasional players or those who do not wish to purchase their own. U12 and softball playing shirts remain included in the cost of subscription.

Non-playing member subscriptions

A modest uplift to subscriptions for non-playing members and dog-walkers is proposed, as follows:
